ALGEBRAIC THINKING IN 3RD GRADE OFTEN INVOLVES UNDERSTANDING PATTERNS AND APPLYING THE ASSOCIATIVE AND DISTRIBUTIVE PROPERTIES OF MULTIPLICATION. PRACTICING A VARIETY OF WORD PROBLEMS THAT REQUIRE THESE SKILLS IS CRUCIAL FOR 3RD GRADE EOG PRACTICE TEST MATH.

MULTIPLICATION AND DIVISION FLUENCY

ACHIEVING FLUENCY IN MULTIPLICATION AND DIVISION FACTS IS A CORNERSTONE OF 3RD GRADE MATH. STUDENTS SHOULD BE

SOLVING WORD PROBLEMS WITH MULTIPLICATION AND DIVISION

A SIGNIFICANT PORTION OF THE 3RD GRADE MATH EOG WILL INVOLVE WORD PROBLEMS THAT REQUIRE STUDENTS TO APPLY THEIR UNDERSTANDING OF MULTIPLICATION AND DIVISION. IDENTIFYING THE CORRECT OPERATION TO USE BASED ON THE WORDING OF THE PROBLEM IS A KEY SKILL TO DEVELOP.

NUMBER AND OPERATIONS IN BASE TEN

IN 3RD GRADE, STUDENTS DEEPEN THEIR UNDERSTANDING OF PLACE VALUE AND CONTINUE TO DEVELOP FLUENCY WITH ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION. THEY ALSO BEGIN TO UNDERSTAND MULTIPLICATION AS REPEATED ADDITION AND DIVISION AS REPEATED SUBTRACTION. ROUNDING NUMBERS TO THE NEAREST 10 OR 100 IS ANOTHER IMPORTANT SKILL IN THIS DOMAIN.

PLACE VALUE AND NUMBER SENSE

STUDENTS SHOULD BE ABLE TO IDENTIFY THE VALUE OF A DIGIT IN A THREE-DIGIT NUMBER BASED ON ITS POSITION (HUNDREDS, TENS, ONES). THEY ALSO LEARN TO COMPARE AND ORDER NUMBERS UP TO 1,000. A STRONG NUMBER SENSE ALLOWS THEM TO ESTIMATE AND MAKE REASONABLE JUDGMENTS ABOUT QUANTITIES.

ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION STRATEGIES

WHILE STUDENTS HAVE LEARNED ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION IN PREVIOUS GRADES, 3RD GRADE FOCUSES ON MASTERING ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION WITHIN 1,000 USING VARIOUS STRATEGIES, INCLUDING REGROUPING. THEY SHOULD BE ABLE TO EXPLAIN THEIR METHODS AND SOLVE MULTI-STEP WORD PROBLEMS INVOLVING THESE OPERATIONS.

NUMBER AND OPERATIONS—FRACTIONS

THIS IS A FOUNDATIONAL YEAR FOR UNDERSTANDING FRACTIONS. STUDENTS LEARN TO RECOGNIZE FRACTIONS AS PARTS OF A WHOLE AND PARTS OF A SET. THEY ALSO EXPLORE EQUIVALENT FRACTIONS AND COMPARE FRACTIONS WITH DIFFERENT NUMERATORS AND DENOMINATORS.

UNDERSTANDING FRACTIONS AS PARTS OF A WHOLE

STUDENTS LEARN TO REPRESENT FRACTIONS USING VISUAL MODELS, SUCH AS FRACTION STRIPS OR CIRCLES. THEY UNDERSTAND THAT A FRACTION REPRESENTS EQUAL PARTS OF A WHOLE. FOR EXAMPLE, $\frac{1}{2}$ MEANS ONE OUT OF TWO EQUAL PARTS.

COMPARING AND ORDERING FRACTIONS

A KEY SKILL IS COMPARING FRACTIONS. STUDENTS LEARN TO COMPARE FRACTIONS WITH THE SAME DENOMINATOR OR THE SAME NUMERATOR BY REASONING ABOUT THEIR SIZE. THEY ALSO LEARN TO REPRESENT FRACTIONS ON A NUMBER LINE.

MEASUREMENT AND DATA

THIS DOMAIN COVERS TELLING TIME, MEASURING LENGTHS, AND UNDERSTANDING CONCEPTS OF MASS AND VOLUME. STUDENTS ALSO LEARN TO REPRESENT AND INTERPRET DATA IN VARIOUS FORMS, SUCH AS BAR GRAPHS, PICTOGRAPHS, AND LINE PLOTS.

TELLING TIME AND MEASURING LENGTH

STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO TELL TIME TO THE NEAREST MINUTE AND MEASURE LENGTHS USING STANDARD UNITS. THEY ALSO LEARN TO SOLVE PROBLEMS INVOLVING ELAPSED TIME AND THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN TWO TIMES.

DATA REPRESENTATION AND INTERPRETATION

INTERPRETING DATA PRESENTED IN CHARTS AND GRAPHS IS CRUCIAL. STUDENTS LEARN TO DRAW AND INTERPRET BAR GRAPHS, PICTOGRAPHS, AND LINE PLOTS TO ANSWER QUESTIONS ABOUT THE DATA. THIS HELPS THEM UNDERSTAND HOW TO ANALYZE AND DRAW CONCLUSIONS FROM INFORMATION.

GEOMETRY

IN GEOMETRY, 3RD GRADERS LEARN TO IDENTIFY AND DRAW TWO-DIMENSIONAL SHAPES BASED ON THEIR ATTRIBUTES. THEY ALSO DEVELOP AN UNDERSTANDING OF AREA AND PERIMETER.

IDENTIFYING TWO-DIMENSIONAL SHAPES

STUDENTS SHOULD BE ABLE TO CLASSIFY SHAPES BY THEIR PROPERTIES, SUCH AS THE NUMBER OF SIDES, ANGLES, AND PARALLEL LINES. THIS INCLUDES UNDERSTANDING QUADRILATERALS LIKE SQUARES, RECTANGLES, PARALLELOGRAMS, AND TRAPEZOIDS.

UNDERSTANDING AREA AND PERIMETER

AREA IS INTRODUCED AS THE MEASURE OF THE SPACE INSIDE A TWO-DIMENSIONAL SHAPE, AND STUDENTS LEARN TO CALCULATE IT BY COUNTING UNIT SQUARES. PERIMETER IS DEFINED AS THE TOTAL DISTANCE AROUND THE OUTSIDE OF A SHAPE, AND STUDENTS LEARN TO FIND IT BY ADDING THE LENGTHS OF ALL SIDES. THESE CONCEPTS ARE OFTEN ASSESSED THROUGH CALCULATION AND WORD PROBLEMS ON THE 3RD GRADE MATH EOG.

STRATEGIES FOR EFFECTIVE 3RD GRADE MATH EOG PRACTICE

ENGAGING IN EFFECTIVE PRACTICE IS THE CORNERSTONE OF SUCCESS ON THE 3RD GRADE MATH EOG. IT'S NOT JUST ABOUT THE QUANTITY OF PRACTICE BUT THE QUALITY AND THE STRATEGIES EMPLOYED. FOCUSING ON WEAK AREAS

WHILE IT'S IMPORTANT TO REINFORCE ALL MATH CONCEPTS, TARGETED PRACTICE ON AREAS OF WEAKNESS IS CRUCIAL FOR IMPROVING OVERALL PERFORMANCE. ANALYZING THE RESULTS OF PRACTICE TESTS OR QUIZZES CAN HELP IDENTIFY SPECIFIC SKILLS OR CONCEPTS THAT A STUDENT STRUGGLES WITH. THE GOAL IS TO ENSURE THE STUDENT FULLY UNDERSTANDS THE CONCEPT BEFORE MOVING ON. REINFORCING CORRECTLY ANSWERED QUESTIONS IS ALSO IMPORTANT TO BUILD CONFIDENCE AND SOLIDIFY KNOWLEDGE.

BUILDING STAMINA FOR THE ACTUAL TEST

THE 3RD GRADE MATH EOG CAN BE A LENGTHY ASSESSMENT. REGULARLY TAKING PRACTICE TESTS HELPS STUDENTS BUILD THE MENTAL STAMINA REQUIRED TO CONCENTRATE AND PERFORM CONSISTENTLY THROUGHOUT THE ENTIRE EXAM. THIS PRACTICE TRAINS THEIR FOCUS AND ENDURANCE, ENSURING THEY CAN MAINTAIN THEIR BEST EFFORT FROM THE BEGINNING TO THE END.

TEACHING RELAXATION TECHNIQUES
