THE STAMP ACT CRISIS (1765)

THE INTOLERABLE ACTS (1774)

THESE ACTS, PASSED IN RESPONSE TO THE BOSTON TEA PARTY, CLOSED THE PORT OF BOSTON, ALTERED THE MASSACHUSETTS CHARTER, ALLOWED BRITISH OFFICIALS TO BE TRIED IN ENGLAND, AND STRENGTHENED THE QUARTERING ACT. THEY WERE SEEN AS A DIRECT ATTACK ON COLONIAL LIBERTIES AND GALVANIZED COLONIAL UNITY.

THE FIRST CONTINENTAL CONGRESS (1774)

REPRESENTATIVES FROM TWELVE OF THE THIRTEEN COLONIES MET IN PHILADELPHIA TO COORDINATE A RESPONSE TO THE INTOLERABLE ACTS. CHAPTER 6 WOULD DISCUSS THEIR DELIBERATIONS, THE DECLARATION OF RIGHTS AND GRIEVANCES, AND THE CALL FOR A BOYCOTT OF BRITISH GOODS.

THE REVOLUTIONARY WAR: KEY BATTLES AND STRATEGIES
