ANTONYM CLUES (CONTRAST)

INFERENCE CLUES (GENERAL CONTEXT)

INFERENCE CLUES REQUIRE THE READER TO PIECE TOGETHER INFORMATION FROM THE ENTIRE SENTENCE OR PASSAGE TO FIGURE OUT THE MEANING OF AN UNFAMILIAR WORD. THERE ISN'T A DIRECT SYNONYM OR ANTONYM, BUT THE OVERALL CONTEXT PROVIDES ENOUGH INFORMATION FOR A LOGICAL GUESS.

EXAMPLE CLUES

EXAMPLE CLUES ARE USED WHEN AN AUTHOR PROVIDES EXAMPLES THAT ILLUSTRATE THE MEANING OF AN UNFAMILIAR WORD. PHRASES LIKE "FOR EXAMPLE," "SUCH AS," OR "INCLUDING" OFTEN INTRODUCE THESE EXAMPLES, GIVING THE READER CONCRETE INSTANCES OF THE WORD'S USAGE.

EXPLANATION CLUES
