ENSURE THE SELECTED CONTENT IS PRESENTED IN A CLEAR, DIGESTIBLE FORMAT, PERHAPS THROUGH EXCERPTS OR SUMMARIES.

CRAFTING CLEAR INSTRUCTIONS
