DISAPPROVAL OR EXCLUSION. THE NOVEL VIVIDLY PORTRAYS HOW THESE EXTERNAL EXPECTATIONS CAN MANIFEST AS INTERNALIZED SHAME, MAKING THE PROCESS OF ACCEPTING ONE'S TRUE SELF AN ARDUOUS BATTLE. EVEN MINOR CHARACTERS CONTRIBUTE TO THE ATMOSPHERE, HIGHLIGHTING THE PERVASIVE NATURE OF SOCIETAL EXPECTATIONS AND THE VARYING DEGREES TO WHICH INDIVIDUALS CONFORM OR QUESTION THEM. THE NOVEL NORMALIZES THE EXISTENCE OF LESBIAN AND BISEXUAL IDENTITIES, PRESENTING THEM NOT AS SENSATIONAL OR PROBLEMATIC, BUT AS A NATURAL PART OF HUMAN EXPERIENCE. THIS REPRESENTATION IS CRUCIAL FOR LGBTQ+ TEENS WHO MIGHT FEEL ISOLATED OR INVISIBLE, OFFERING THEM A SENSE OF VALIDATION AND THE KNOWLEDGE THAT THEIR FEELINGS ARE UNDERSTOOD AND SHARED. THE NOVEL HELPS TO DISMANTLE THE IDEA THAT THERE IS ONLY ONE "NORMAL" WAY TO LOVE OR TO BE.

CHALLENGING HETERONORMATIVE ASSUMPTIONS

PETERS USES JASMINE'S NARRATIVE TO DECONSTRUCT THESE ASSUMPTIONS, SHOWING HOW THEY CAN BE HARMFUL AND RESTRICTIVE. BY PRESENTING A COMPELLING AND RELATABLE SAME-SEX ROMANCE, THE NOVEL IMPLICITLY ARGUES THAT LOVE AND ATTRACTION EXIST ON A SPECTRUM AND THAT JUDGING INDIVIDUALS BASED ON THEIR
