CHALLENGES OF ENFORCEMENT ARE OFTEN MULTIFACETED, INVOLVING ISSUES OF POLITICAL WILL, BUREAUCRATIC INERTIA, AND THE POTENTIAL FOR LEGAL CHALLENGES OR EVASION BY REGULATED ENTITIES.
