THE DIGITAL AGE HAS ALSO MADE PEOPLE ACCUSTOMED TO ACCESSING A VAST ARRAY OF CONTENT ONLINE, OFTEN FOR FREE, WHICH CAN EXTEND TO LITERARY WORKS.
