THE BAR EXAM PROCESS IN MASSACHUSETTS

FOR ANY CANDIDATE, INCLUDING A DISTINGUISHED INDIVIDUAL LIKE JOHN F. KENNEDY, PASSING THIS EXAMINATION WAS A CRITICAL HURDLE TO CLEAR BEFORE BEING OFFICIALLY RECOGNIZED AS A LICENSED ATTORNEY. THE QUESTION OF HOW MANY TIMES JFK TOOK THE BAR EXAM IS DIRECTLY ANSWERED BY EXAMINING THE OFFICIAL RECORDS OF HIS ADMISSION TO THE MASSACHUSETTS BAR.
