THIS IS BECAUSE THE WORK IS NOT CONSIDERED ORIGINAL FOR THE CURRENT ACADEMIC CONTEXT.

ACCIDENTAL PLAGIARISM

THIS CAN OCCUR DUE TO CARELESSNESS, SUCH AS FORGETTING TO CITE A SOURCE, MISPLACING NOTES, OR INCORRECTLY ATTRIBUTING INFORMATION. STRATEGIES FOR AVOIDING PLAGIARISM

- WHEN PARAPHRASING, ENSURE YOU SIGNIFICANTLY REPHRASE THE ORIGINAL TEXT IN YOUR OWN WORDS AND SENTENCE STRUCTURE, AND ALWAYS PROVIDE A CITATION.
- KEEP METICULOUS RECORDS OF ALL SOURCES USED DURING RESEARCH, INCLUDING AUTHOR, TITLE, PUBLICATION DATE, AND PAGE NUMBERS.
- UTILIZE CITATION MANAGEMENT TOOLS LIKE ZOTERO, MENDELEY, OR ENDNOTE TO ORGANIZE YOUR SOURCES AND GENERATE BIBLIOGRAPHIES.

7. *INVESTIGATING SOURCES: EFFECTIVE RESEARCH AND SOURCE EVALUATION*. THIS GUIDE FOCUSES ON THE ESSENTIAL SKILL OF FINDING, EVALUATING, AND USING SOURCES EFFECTIVELY AND ETHICALLY.
