CORA SMITH: THE RESTLESS HOUSEWIFE

CORA SMITH IS EQUALLY COMPLEX, A WOMAN TRAPPED BY CIRCUMSTANCE AND YEARNING FOR A LIFE BEYOND THE DRUDGERY OF HER MARRIAGE AND DINER WORK. HER AGENCY IN THE PLOT, DESPITE THE PATRIARCHAL SOCIETY DEPICTED, IS A SIGNIFICANT ASPECT OF HER PORTRAYAL.

NICK PAPADAKIS: THE UNWITTING HUSBAND

NICK PAPADAKIS SERVES AS THE FOIL TO FRANK AND CORA'S ILLICIT PASSION. HE IS A SIMPLE, HARDWORKING MAN, UNAWARE OF THE DANGER LURKING BENEATH THE SURFACE OF HIS OWN HOME. HIS PRESENCE HIGHLIGHTS THE BETRAYAL AT THE HEART OF THE STORY AND UNDERScores THE RUTHLESSNESS OF FRANK AND CORA'S PLAN. THE NOIR BLUEPRINT: THE POSTMAN ALWAYS RINGS TWICE'S IMPACT ON THE GENRE
