KEY POLICIES AND PRESIDENTIAL INITIATIVES

HIS MEASURED APPROACH AND WILLINGNESS TO NEGOTIATE, WHILE MAINTAINING A STRONG STANCE, ULTIMATELY LED TO THE WITHDRAWAL OF SOVIET MISSILES FROM CUBA, AVERTING A CATASTROPHIC CONFLICT AND SOLIDIFYING HIS REPUTATION AS A CAPABLE CRISIS MANAGER.

THE SPACE RACE: REACHING FOR THE STARS

DRIVEN BY COMPETITION WITH THE SOVIET UNION IN TECHNOLOGICAL AND IDEOLOGICAL SPHERES, PRESIDENT KENNEDY BOLDLY COMMITTED THE UNITED STATES TO LANDING A MAN ON THE MOON BEFORE THE END OF THE 1960s. THIS AMBITIOUS GOAL, ARTICULATED IN HIS FAMOUS "WE CHOOSE TO GO TO THE MOON" SPEECH, SPURRED SIGNIFICANT INVESTMENT IN THE APOLLO PROGRAM AND THE NATIONAL AERONAUTICS AND SPACE ADMINISTRATION (NASA).
