HIS PURPOSE WAS CLEAR: TO RECORD THE EVENTS OF THE FOURTH CRUSADE FROM A PERSPECTIVE THAT DEFENDED THE ACTIONS OF THE CRUSADERS, PARTICULARLY THOSE HE KNEW AND RESPECTED. HIS NARRATIVE IS MARKED BY A SENSE OF DUTY AND A DESIRE TO PORTRAY THE CRUSADE AS A DIVINELY SANCTIONED ENDEAVOR, EVEN IN THE FACE OF ITS INCREASINGLY PROBLEMATIC TRAJECTORY.

JEAN DE JOINVILLE: THE SENESCHAL OF CHAMPAGNE

JEAN DE JOINVILLE, BORN IN 1224, WAS A YOUNGER CONTEMPORARY OF VILLEHARDOUIN AND A MORE DIRECT PARTICIPANT IN THE EVENTS HE DESCRIBED. HE SERVED AS SENESCHAL OF CHAMPAGNE AND WAS A CLOSE COMPANION OF KING LOUIS IX OF FRANCE DURING THE SEVENTH CRUSADE. JOINVILLE'S PERSONAL RELATIONSHIP WITH THE SAINTLY KING PROFOUNDLY SHAPED HIS CHRONICLE, "THE HISTORY OF SAINT LOUIS." HIS CHRONICLE IS MORE INTIMATE, FILLED WITH PERSONAL REFLECTIONS, DIALOGUES, AND OBSERVATIONS OF THE KING'S SPIRITUAL AND PERSONAL LIFE. THIS DIFFERENCE IN FOCUS REFLECTS THEIR RESPECTIVE RELATIONSHIPS WITH THE EVENTS AND INDIVIDUALS THEY CHRONICLED.
