- HOW DOES THE ENVIRONMENT OF THE EARTH'S INTERIOR AFFECT THE EXPLORERS' MORALE AND PHYSICAL CONDITION?
- WHAT IS THE SYMBOLIC SIGNIFICANCE OF THE DIFFERENT ENVIRONMENTS THEY ENCOUNTER?

CRITICAL THINKING AND ANALYSIS ACTIVITIES

IF WORKING IN A GROUP OR CLASS SETTING, DISCUSS YOUR ANSWERS AND INTERPRETATIONS WITH CLASSMATES. DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVES CAN OFFER NEW INSIGHTS AND DEEPEN YOUR UNDERSTANDING OF THE NOVEL.
