UNLIKE SIMPLE INFERENCE, CONCLUSIONS ARE BROADER AND OFTEN SUMMARIZE AN OVERALL UNDERSTANDING OF THE TEXT. THIS SKILL ENABLES STUDENTS TO FORM OPINIONS OR JUDGMENTS SUPPORTED BY EVIDENCE, WHICH IS CRUCIAL FOR CRITICAL READING AND ANALYTICAL WRITING.
