

MALE CONCUBINES IN HISTORY

HADRIAN AND ANTINOUS

IN ROMAN HISTORY, EMPEROR HADRIAN'S COMPANION ANTINOUS IS A NOTABLE FIGURE. WHILE NOT OFFICIALLY A CONCUBINE BY TITLE, THEIR INTIMATE RELATIONSHIP WAS HIGHLY INFLUENTIAL. AFTER ANTINOUS'S DEATH, HADRIAN DEIFIED HIM, UNDERSCORING THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THEIR BOND.

ROLES AND STATUS OF MALE CONCUBINES
