UNDERSTANDING THE NEOLITHIC REVOLUTION

THE NEOLITHIC REVOLUTION, ALSO KNOWN AS THE AGRICULTURAL REVOLUTION, WAS A FUNDAMENTAL SHIFT IN HUMAN HISTORY OCCURRING AROUND 10,000 BCE.
