2. BEST GAZE

ASSESSES VOLUNTARY EYE MOVEMENTS. THE EXAMINER CHECKS IF THE PATIENT CAN TRACK OBJECTS HORIZONTALLY WITHOUT DEVIATION OR FORCED GAZE PREFERENCE.

3. VISUAL FIELDS

THIS TESTS THE PATIENT'S PERIPHERAL VISION BY ASSESSING THE FOUR QUADRANTS OF EACH EYE. DEFICITS SUCH AS HEMIANOPIA ARE NOTED AND SCORED ACCORDINGLY.

4. FACIAL PALSY

MEASURES FACIAL MUSCLE WEAKNESS. THE PATIENT IS ASKED TO SHOW TEETH OR RAISE EYEBROWS, AND ASYMMETRY IS SCORED BASED ON SEVERITY.

5. MOTOR FUNCTION (ARM AND LEG)

MOTOR STRENGTH IS EVALUATED SEPARATELY FOR THE LEFT AND RIGHT ARMS AND LEGS. THE PATIENT IS ASKED TO HOLD LIMBS UP AGAINST GRAVITY AND RESISTANCE, WITH SCORES RANGING FROM NO DRIFT TO NO MOVEMENT.

6. LIMB ATAXIA

THIS TESTS COORDINATION THROUGH FINGER-TO-NOSE AND HEEL-TO-SHIN MANEUVERS, IDENTIFYING CEREBELLAR DYSFUNCTION.

7. SENSORY

ASSESSES THE PATIENT'S RESPONSE TO PINPRICK STIMULI ON VARIOUS BODY PARTS TO DETECT SENSORY LOSS.

8. LANGUAGE

EVALUATES EXPRESSIVE APHASIA BY ASKING THE PATIENT TO DESCRIBE A PICTURE AND NAME OBJECTS. ERRORS IN FLUENCY OR COMPREHENSION ARE SCORED.

9. DYSARTHRIA

ASSESSES SPEECH CLARITY BY HAVING THE PATIENT REPEAT WORDS OR SENTENCES. SLURRED OR UNINTELLIGIBLE SPEECH INCREASES THE SCORE.

10. EXTINCTION AND INATTENTION (NEGLECT)

TESTS FOR SPATIAL NEGLECT BY SIMULTANEOUSLY STIMULATING BOTH SIDES OF THE BODY AND OBSERVING THE PATIENT'S AWARENESS.

INTERPRETING NIH STROKE SCALE TEST ANSWERS

SCORE RANGES AND STROKE SEVERITY

THE TOTAL NIH STROKE SCALE SCORE CATEGORIZES STROKE SEVERITY AS FOLLOWS:

- 0: NO STROKE SYMPTOMS
- 1-4: MINOR STROKE
- 5-15: MODERATE STROKE
- 16-20: MODERATE TO SEVERE STROKE
- 21-42: SEVERE STROKE

EXAMPLES OF NIH STROKE SCALE TEST ANSWERS
