EXAM FORMAT AND SCORING

PRE-LICENSING EDUCATION

NEW YORK REQUIRES PROSPECTIVE ACCIDENT AND HEALTH INSURANCE AGENTS AND BROKERS TO COMPLETE A PRE-LICENSING EDUCATION COURSE. THIS COURSE COVERS EXAM-RELEVANT MATERIAL AND IS DESIGNED TO PREPARE CANDIDATES THOROUGHLY FOR THE LICENSING EXAM.

TYPICALLY, CANDIDATES MUST COMPLETE 40 HOURS OF APPROVED COURSEWORK, WHICH MAY BE OFFERED THROUGH ACCREDITED PROVIDERS IN CLASSROOM OR ONLINE FORMATS.

BACKGROUND CHECKS AND FINGERPRINTING
