INTERVENTION DOCUMENTATION

SESSION NOTES DETAIL THE THERAPEUTIC ACTIVITIES EMPLOYED, THE CHILD'S ENGAGEMENT AND RESPONSE, AND ANY MODIFICATIONS MADE. THIS ONGOING RECORD DEMONSTRATES PROGRESS TOWARD GOALS AND INFORMS FUTURE TREATMENT DECISIONS.

PROGRESS MONITORING AND OUTCOME MEASURES

REGULAR UPDATES ON THE CHILD'S PROGRESS TOWARD GOALS, INCLUDING QUANTITATIVE AND QUALITATIVE DATA, HELP EVALUATE EFFECTIVENESS. OUTCOME MEASURES MAY INCLUDE PARENT OR TEACHER REPORTS, STANDARDIZED REASSESSMENTS, AND FUNCTIONAL OBSERVATIONS.

- **TREATMENT PLAN:** WEEKLY 45-MINUTE SESSIONS FOCUSING ON SENSORY INTEGRATION ACTIVITIES AND FINE MOTOR SKILL DEVELOPMENT

SAMPLE PROGRESS NOTE

A TYPICAL PROGRESS NOTE FOLLOWS THE SOAP FORMAT (SUBJECTIVE, OBJECTIVE, ASSESSMENT, PLAN) OR NARRATIVE STYLE. EXAMPLE:

- **SUBJECTIVE:** PARENT REPORTS CHILD IS MORE WILLING TO ENGAGE IN DRESSING TASKS AT HOME.
- **OBJECTIVE:** CHILD COMPLETED 3-STEP DRESSING SEQUENCE WITH MINIMAL PROMPTS; DEMONSTRATED IMPROVED BILATERAL COORDINATION.
- **ASSESSMENT:** PROGRESS NOTED IN MOTOR PLANNING AND SELF-CARE INDEPENDENCE; CONTINUE SENSORY INTEGRATION APPROACH.
- **PLAN:** CONTINUE CURRENT INTERVENTION; INTRODUCE FINE MOTOR GAMES TO IMPROVE HAND STRENGTH NEXT SESSION.

SAMPLE DISCHARGE SUMMARY

DISCHARGE DOCUMENTATION SUMMARIZES THERAPY OUTCOMES, GOAL ACHIEVEMENT, AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR FOLLOW-UP. FOR EXAMPLE:

- CLIENT MET 80% OF GOALS RELATED TO FINE MOTOR COORDINATION AND SENSORY PROCESSING.

GOALS SHOULD BE SPECIFIC, MEASURABLE, ACHIEVABLE, RELEVANT, AND TIME-BOUND (SMART). FUNCTIONAL GOALS HIGHLIGHT HOW THERAPY WILL IMPROVE THE CHILD'S PARTICIPATION IN DAILY ACTIVITIES AND ENVIRONMENTS.

MAINTAIN TIMELY AND CONSISTENT DOCUMENTATION

DOCUMENT SESSIONS PROMPTLY TO ENSURE ACCURACY AND COMPLETENESS. CONSISTENT RECORDS FACILITATE TRACKING PROGRESS AND SUPPORT CONTINUITY OF CARE.

INCORPORATE FAMILY AND CAREGIVER INPUT

DOCUMENT OBSERVATIONS AND FEEDBACK FROM PARENTS OR CAREGIVERS, AS THEIR INSIGHTS PROVIDE VALUABLE CONTEXT AND SUPPORT COLLABORATIVE CARE PLANNING.

COMMON CHALLENGES AND SOLUTIONS IN PEDIATRIC THERAPY DOCUMENTATION

THERAPISTS SHOULD DESCRIBE THE SPECIFIC SENSORY ACTIVITIES USED, THE CHILD'S RESPONSE TO THESE ACTIVITIES, ANY MODIFICATIONS MADE, AND THE IMPACT ON THE CHILD'S FUNCTIONAL ABILITIES AND BEHAVIOR.

WHAT ARE BEST PRACTICES FOR DOCUMENTING PEDIATRIC OT EVALUATIONS?
