OCS IS BOTH A TEST AND A CRUCIBLE, EMPHASIZING LEADERSHIP, TEAMWORK, AND COMBAT READINESS.

STRUCTURE AND CURRICULUM

OCS IS DIVIDED INTO PHASES FOCUSING ON PHYSICAL CONDITIONING, LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT, AND MILITARY TACTICS. CANDIDATES ENGAGE IN OBSTACLE COURSES, MARKSMANSHIP TRAINING, LAND NAVIGATION, AND CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION ON MARINE CORPS DOCTRINE. TBS ENSURES THAT EVERY MARINE OFFICER, REGARDLESS OF SPECIALTY, HAS A SOLID FOUNDATION IN COMBAT LEADERSHIP AND MARINE CORPS WARFIGHTING PRINCIPLES.

SPECIALIZED TRAINING

AFTER TBS, OFFICERS PROCEED TO MOS-SPECIFIC TRAINING SCHOOLS WHERE THEY ACQUIRE THE EXPERTISE REQUIRED FOR THEIR PARTICULAR FIELDS, SUCH AS AVIATION, INTELLIGENCE, LOGISTICS, OR ARTILLERY. THIS PHASE ENHANCES THEIR ABILITY TO LEAD WITHIN THEIR SPECIALTY AND CONTRIBUTE EFFECTIVELY TO THEIR UNITS.

CONTINUOUS LEADERSHIP GROWTH

COURAGE

COURAGE INVOLVES FACING FEAR AND ADVERSITY WITH RESOLVE. OFFICERS MUST DEMONSTRATE PHYSICAL BRAVERY ON THE BATTLEFIELD AND MORAL COURAGE TO MAKE DIFFICULT DECISIONS THAT AFFECT LIVES AND MISSION OUTCOMES.

COMMITMENT

COMMITMENT REFLECTS DEDICATION TO THE MISSION, FELLOW MARINES, AND THE CORPS. THIS VALUE DRIVES OFFICERS TO PERSEVERE THROUGH CHALLENGES AND CONTINUOUSLY STRIVE FOR EXCELLENCE IN LEADERSHIP AND DUTY.

CHALLENGES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MARINE OFFICERS

THE ROLE OF A MARINE OFFICER ENCOMPASSES SIGNIFICANT CHALLENGES AND RESPONSIBILITIES THAT TEST EVERY ASPECT OF THEIR TRAINING AND CHARACTER. LEADING MARINES IN COMPLEX OPERATIONS DEMANDS ADAPTABILITY, RESILIENCE, AND UNWAVERING DEDICATION.

OPERATIONAL LEADERSHIP
