THESE PRINCIPLES COLLECTIVELY AIM TO CREATE AN INTERNATIONAL ORDER GROUNDED IN LAW AND MORALITY RATHER THAN POWER AND CONQUEST.

THE ROLE OF COSMOPOLITANISM
