THE NATURE OF THESE QUESTIONS OFTEN TRANSCENDS EMPIRICAL DATA, ADDRESSING ABSTRACT AND CONCEPTUAL ISSUES THAT SHAPE HUMAN UNDERSTANDING.

WHY QUESTIONS MATTER IN PHILOSOPHY

METHODS OF PHILOSOPHICAL INQUIRY
