UNDERSTANDING THE PHONEME GRAPHEME MAPPING GRID

BY BREAKING DOWN WORDS INTO THEIR CONSTITUENT PHONEMES AND ALIGNING THEM WITH GRAPHEMES, THE GRID PROVIDES A CLEAR, STEP-BY-STEP METHOD FOR LEARNERS TO PROCESS AND PRODUCE LANGUAGE.
