THE IMPORTANCE OF POLICE COMMUNITY RELATIONS

MOREOVER, STRONG POLICE COMMUNITY RELATIONS CONTRIBUTE TO REDUCING TENSIONS AND CONFLICTS, ENABLING LAW ENFORCEMENT TO RESPOND MORE EFFECTIVELY TO PUBLIC SAFETY CONCERNS.
