UNDERSTANDING PSYCHOLOGICAL TESTING AND ASSESSMENT

DEFINITION AND PURPOSE

THESE TESTS ASSIST IN DIAGNOSING INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES, GIFTEDNESS, AND COGNITIVE IMPAIRMENTS.

PERSONALITY TESTS

PERSONALITY ASSESSMENTS AIM TO UNDERSTAND INDIVIDUAL DIFFERENCES IN TRAITS, BEHAVIORS, AND EMOTIONAL PATTERNS. THEY CAN BE OBJECTIVE, SUCH AS THE MINNESOTA MULTIPHASIC PERSONALITY INVENTORY (MMPI), OR PROJECTIVE, LIKE THE RORSCHACH INKBLOT TEST. THESE INSTRUMENTS ARE ESSENTIAL IN CLINICAL DIAGNOSIS, COUNSELING, AND PERSONNEL SELECTION.

NEUROPSYCHOLOGICAL TESTS

NEUROPSYCHOLOGICAL TESTING EVALUATES BRAIN FUNCTION AND COGNITIVE DEFICITS RESULTING FROM NEUROLOGICAL CONDITIONS. APPLICATIONS OF PSYCHOLOGICAL TESTING AND ASSESSMENT

FORENSIC PSYCHOLOGY

FORENSIC ASSESSMENT ASSISTS LEGAL DECISION-MAKING BY EVALUATING COMPETENCY TO STAND TRIAL, RISK OF REOFFENDING, AND MENTAL STATE AT THE TIME OF AN OFFENSE. THESE EVALUATIONS REQUIRE SPECIALIZED KNOWLEDGE OF LEGAL STANDARDS AND ETHICAL GUIDELINES.

ETHICAL CONSIDERATIONS IN PSYCHOLOGICAL TESTING
