UNDERSTANDING ANGLE MEASURES

DEFINITION OF ANGLE

MEASURING ANGLES

EXAMPLE PROBLEM 2: SOLVING FOR AN ANGLE USING SUPPLEMENTARY ANGLES

TWO ANGLES ARE SUPPLEMENTARY, AND ONE ANGLE IS REPRESENTED BY $3x + 10$, WHILE THE OTHER IS $2x - 5$. FIND THE VALUE OF X AND THE MEASURES OF BOTH ANGLES.

1. WRITE THE SUPPLEMENTARY EQUATION: $(3x + 10) + (2x - 5) = 180$
2. SIMPLIFY: $5x + 5 = 180$
3. SOLVE FOR X: $5x = 175$ $\div$ $x = 35$
4. CALCULATE ANGLES: $3(35) + 10 = 115^\circ$, $2(35) - 5 = 65^\circ$
5. VERIFY SUM: $115^\circ + 65^\circ = 180^\circ$

EXAMPLE PROBLEM 3: VERTICAL ANGLES EQUALITY

TWO VERTICAL ANGLES ARE GIVEN AS $4x + 20$ AND $6x - 10$. FIND X AND THE ANGLE MEASURES.

1. SET THE ANGLES EQUAL: $4x + 20 = 6x - 10$
2. SOLVE FOR X: $20 + 10 = 6x - 4x$ $\div$ $30 = 2x$ $\div$ $x = 15$
3. CALCULATE ANGLES: $4(15) + 20 = 80^\circ$, $6(15) - 10 = 80^\circ$
4. CONFIRM EQUALITY OF VERTICAL ANGLES: BOTH 80°
