HISTORICAL OVERVIEW OF HURRICANES IN SARASOTA

THE HISTORY OF HURRICANES IN SARASOTA, FLORIDA, DATES BACK WELL BEFORE THE MODERN ERA OF METEOROLOGY. THE REGION'S COASTAL LOCATION ON THE GULF OF MEXICO MAKES IT SUSCEPTIBLE TO TROPICAL STORMS AND HURRICANES FORMING IN THE ATLANTIC BASIN. EARLY RECORDED HURRICANES

HISTORICAL DOCUMENTATION FROM THE LATE 1800S AND EARLY 1900S SHOWS THAT SARASOTA EXPERIENCED SEVERAL HURRICANES THAT BROUGHT HEAVY WINDS AND FLOODING. THESE EARLY STORMS OFTEN WENT UNTRACKED OR WERE POORLY DOCUMENTED DUE TO LIMITED TECHNOLOGY BUT LEFT LASTING IMPRESSIONS ON THE COMMUNITY.

DEVELOPMENT OF METEOROLOGICAL TRACKING

WITH THE ADVANCEMENT OF METEOROLOGICAL TECHNOLOGY IN THE MID-20TH CENTURY, TRACKING AND PREDICTING HURRICANES IMPROVED DRASTICALLY. SARASOTA BENEFITED FROM THESE DEVELOPMENTS, ALLOWING FOR BETTER WARNING SYSTEMS AND EMERGENCY PLANNING.

MAJOR HURRICANES IMPACTING SARASOTA

SEVERAL HURRICANES HAVE SIGNIFICANTLY IMPACTED SARASOTA, FLORIDA, OVER THE YEARS. THESE STORMS VARIED IN STRENGTH BUT COMMONLY RESULTED IN CONSIDERABLE PROPERTY DAMAGE, INFRASTRUCTURE CHALLENGES, AND DISRUPTIONS TO

DAILY LIFE.

HURRICANE DONNA (1960)

HURRICANE DONNA WAS ONE OF THE MOST DESTRUCTIVE STORMS TO HIT SARASOTA IN THE 20TH CENTURY. MAKING LANDFALL AS A CATEGORY 4 HURRICANE, DONNA CAUSED WIDESPREAD WIND DAMAGE AND STORM SURGE FLOODING. THE STORM'S IMPACT LED TO SIGNIFICANT REBUILDING EFFORTS ACROSS THE REGION.

HURRICANE CHARLEY (2004)

IN 2004, HURRICANE CHARLEY STRUCK THE GULF COAST, INCLUDING SARASOTA, WITH INTENSE WINDS AND HEAVY RAINFALL. THOUGH THE STORM'S EYE PASSED SLIGHTLY NORTH OF SARASOTA, THE CITY STILL EXPERIENCED SUBSTANTIAL DAMAGE TO HOMES, BUSINESSES, AND PUBLIC INFRASTRUCTURE.

HURRICANE IRMA (2017)

HURRICANE IRMA WAS A CATEGORY 4 STORM THAT PASSED NEAR SARASOTA, BRINGING STRONG WINDS AND FLOODING. IT TESTED THE CITY'S EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS PLANS AND RESULTED IN POWER OUTAGES AND PROPERTY DAMAGE. IRMA HIGHLIGHTED THE NEED FOR CONTINUED INVESTMENT IN RESILIENCE AND RECOVERY PROGRAMS.

PATTERNS AND TRENDS IN SARASOTA'S HURRICANE ACTIVITY

SEASONAL FREQUENCY

INCREASING STORM INTENSITY

COMMUNITY AND PUBLIC HEALTH

STORMS DISRUPT DAILY LIFE, DISPLACE RESIDENTS, AND POSE PUBLIC HEALTH RISKS DUE TO FLOODING AND POWER OUTAGES. SARASOTA HAS WORKED TO IMPROVE SHELTERS, HEALTHCARE ACCESS, AND COMMUNICATION DURING EMERGENCIES.

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE IN SARASOTA

SARASOTA'S HISTORY WITH HURRICANES HAS DRIVEN THE DEVELOPMENT OF ROBUST EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PRACTICES DESIGNED TO PROTECT RESIDENTS AND PROPERTY.

HOW OFTEN DOES SARASOTA, FLORIDA EXPERIENCE HURRICANES?

SARASOTA EXPERIENCES HURRICANES AND TROPICAL STORMS TYPICALLY DURING THE ATLANTIC HURRICANE SEASON, WHICH RUNS FROM JUNE 1 TO NOVEMBER 30, WITH MAJOR EVENTS OCCURRING ROUGHLY EVERY FEW YEARS.

WHAT MEASURES HAS SARASOTA TAKEN TO PREPARE FOR HURRICANES?

SARASOTA HAS IMPLEMENTED BUILDING CODES, EMERGENCY EVACUATION PLANS, AND COMMUNITY AWARENESS PROGRAMS TO PREPARE FOR HURRICANES, INCLUDING HURRICANE SHELTERS AND EARLY WARNING SYSTEMS TO PROTECT RESIDENTS.

HAS SARASOTA, FLORIDA EVER BEEN DIRECTLY HIT BY A MAJOR HURRICANE?

WHILE SARASOTA HAS BEEN CLOSE TO THE PATHS OF SEVERAL MAJOR HURRICANES, IT HAS RARELY BEEN DIRECTLY HIT BY A CATEGORY 4 OR 5 STORM. HOWEVER, HURRICANES LIKE CHARLEY IN 2004 CAME VERY CLOSE, CAUSING SIGNIFICANT IMPACT.

WHAT WAS THE IMPACT OF HURRICANE IRMA ON SARASOTA, FLORIDA?

HURRICANE IRMA IN 2017 CAUSED EXTENSIVE POWER OUTAGES, FLOODING, AND PROPERTY DAMAGE IN SARASOTA, LEADING TO A SIGNIFICANT RECOVERY EFFORT AND IMPROVEMENTS IN EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS.

ARE HURRICANES BECOMING MORE FREQUENT OR INTENSE IN SARASOTA, FLORIDA?
