SUBJECT-VERB AGREEMENT

SUBJECT-VERB AGREEMENT IS A FOUNDATIONAL RULE IN ENGLISH GRAMMAR AND A FREQUENT FOCUS ON THE SAT. IT REQUIRES THAT THE VERB IN A SENTENCE MATCHES THE SUBJECT IN NUMBER—SINGULAR OR PLURAL. ERRORS IN AGREEMENT CAN CONFUSE MEANING AND UNDERMINE CLARITY.

BASIC AGREEMENT RULES

SINGULAR SUBJECTS TAKE SINGULAR VERBS, AND PLURAL SUBJECTS TAKE PLURAL VERBS. FOR EXAMPLE, "THE DOG BARKS" USES A SINGULAR VERB, WHILE "THE DOGS BARK" USES A PLURAL VERB. THIS RULE APPLIES REGARDLESS OF INTERVENING WORDS OR PHRASES BETWEEN THE SUBJECT AND VERB.

TRICKY AGREEMENT SITUATIONS

SOME SUBJECTS CAN BE MISLEADING, SUCH AS COLLECTIVE NOUNS, INDEFINITE PRONOUNS, OR COMPOUND SUBJECTS JOINED BY "AND" OR "OR."

- COLLECTIVE NOUNS (E.G., TEAM, COMMITTEE) USUALLY TAKE SINGULAR VERBS.
- INDEFINITE PRONOUNS LIKE EVERYONE, SOMEONE, OR EACH ARE SINGULAR AND REQUIRE SINGULAR VERBS.
- SUBJECTS JOINED BY "AND" ARE GENERALLY PLURAL, WHILE THOSE JOINED BY "OR" OR "NOR" AGREE WITH THE CLOSEST SUBJECT.

VERB TENSES AND VERB FORMS

UNDERSTANDING VERB TENSES ENSURES THAT ACTIONS ARE CLEARLY PLACED IN TIME, WHICH IS ESSENTIAL FOR COHERENCE IN WRITING. THE SAT TESTS CONSISTENT USE OF VERB TENSES AND CORRECT VERB FORMS TO AVOID CONFUSION.

CONSISTENT VERB TENSE

SENTENCES SHOULD MAINTAIN THE SAME TENSE UNLESS A CHANGE IN TIME FRAME IS INDICATED. SHIFTS BETWEEN PAST, PRESENT, AND FUTURE TENSES WITHOUT CAUSE ARE ERRORS.

COMMON VERB FORMS

RECOGNIZING BASE, PAST, PAST PARTICIPLE, AND PRESENT PARTICIPLE FORMS IS NECESSARY FOR PROPER VERB USAGE. IRREGULAR VERBS REQUIRE SPECIAL ATTENTION SINCE THEIR FORMS DO NOT FOLLOW STANDARD PATTERNS.

PUNCTUATION RULES

PUNCTUATION PLAYS A CRITICAL ROLE IN CLARIFYING MEANING AND INDICATING SENTENCE STRUCTURE. THE SAT FREQUENTLY TESTS CORRECT USE OF COMMAS, SEMICOLONS, COLONS, AND APOSTROPHES.

COMMA USAGE

COMMAS SEPARATE ELEMENTS IN A LIST, SET OFF INTRODUCTORY PHRASES, AND JOIN INDEPENDENT CLAUSES WITH COORDINATING CONJUNCTIONS. MISPLACED OR MISSING COMMAS OFTEN CAUSE ERRORS.

SEMICOLONS AND COLONS

SEMICOLONS CONNECT CLOSELY RELATED INDEPENDENT CLAUSES WITHOUT CONJUNCTIONS, WHILE COLONS INTRODUCE LISTS, EXPLANATIONS, OR QUOTATIONS. BOTH MUST BE USED WITH PRECISION.

APOSTROPHES

APOSTROPHES INDICATE POSSESSION OR FORM CONTRACTIONS. CONFUSING APOSTROPHES WITH PLURAL FORMS IS A COMMON MISTAKE.

SENTENCE STRUCTURE AND FRAGMENTS

COMPLETE SENTENCES MUST HAVE A SUBJECT AND A VERB AND EXPRESS A COMPLETE THOUGHT. THE SAT TESTS THE ABILITY TO IDENTIFY SENTENCE FRAGMENTS AND RUN-ON SENTENCES.

IDENTIFYING FRAGMENTS

SENTENCE FRAGMENTS LACK EITHER A SUBJECT, A VERB, OR A COMPLETE IDEA. RECOGNIZING THESE INCOMPLETE STRUCTURES HELPS AVOID ERRORS IN SENTENCE CONSTRUCTION.

RUN-ON SENTENCES AND COMMA SPLICES

RUN-ONS OCCUR WHEN TWO INDEPENDENT CLAUSES ARE JOINED IMPROPERLY. COMMA SPLICES HAPPEN WHEN ONLY A COMMA CONNECTS TWO INDEPENDENT CLAUSES WITHOUT A COORDINATING CONJUNCTION.

PRONOUNS AND AGREEMENT

PRONOUNS MUST AGREE WITH THEIR ANTECEDENTS IN NUMBER, GENDER, AND PERSON. ERRORS IN PRONOUN AGREEMENT CONFUSE THE READER ABOUT WHO OR WHAT IS BEING REFERENCED.

PRONOUN-ANTECEDENT AGREEMENT

SINGULAR ANTECEDENTS REQUIRE SINGULAR PRONOUNS, AND PLURAL ANTECEDENTS REQUIRE PLURAL PRONOUNS. INDEFINITE PRONOUNS ALSO REQUIRE CAREFUL AGREEMENT.

PRONOUN CASE

SUBJECTIVE PRONOUNS (I, HE, SHE, THEY) SERVE AS SUBJECTS, WHILE OBJECTIVE PRONOUNS (ME, HIM, HER, THEM) SERVE AS OBJECTS. USING THE CORRECT CASE MAINTAINS SENTENCE CLARITY.

COMMONLY CONFUSED WORDS

THE SAT OFTEN TESTS THE CORRECT USAGE OF WORDS THAT SOUND ALIKE OR ARE FREQUENTLY MISUSED. UNDERSTANDING THEIR MEANINGS AND CONTEXTS IS ESSENTIAL FOR ACCURACY.

EXAMPLES OF CONFUSED WORDS

- ITS VS. IT'S
- THERE VS. THEIR VS. THEY'RE
- THAN VS. THEN
- EFFECT VS. AFFECT
- WHO VS. WHOM

MODIFIERS AND PARALLELISM

MODIFIERS ADD DETAIL AND CLARITY BUT MUST BE PLACED CORRECTLY TO AVOID AMBIGUITY. PARALLELISM REQUIRES THAT ELEMENTS IN A SERIES OR COMPARISON MAINTAIN THE SAME GRAMMATICAL FORM.

CORRECT MODIFIER PLACEMENT

MODIFIERS SHOULD BE CLOSE TO THE WORDS THEY DESCRIBE TO PREVENT CONFUSION. DANGLING OR MISPLACED MODIFIERS

OFTEN CAUSE MEANING ERRORS.

PARALLEL STRUCTURE

ITEMS IN A LIST OR JOINED BY CONJUNCTIONS SHOULD FOLLOW THE SAME GRAMMATICAL PATTERN. THIS CONSISTENCY IMPROVES READABILITY AND STYLE.
