UNDERSTANDING SHAWN WILSON'S CONCEPT OF RESEARCH IS CEREMONY

SHAWN WILSON'S RESEARCH IS CEREMONY FRAMEWORK REDEFINES THE ACT OF RESEARCH AS AN INHERENTLY RELATIONAL AND SPIRITUAL PROCESS, ROOTED IN INDIGENOUS KNOWLEDGE SYSTEMS. ACCORDING TO WILSON, RESEARCH IS NOT A NEUTRAL OR DETACHED ACTIVITY BUT A CEREMONY THAT INVOLVES RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY, AND RECIPROCITY BETWEEN THE RESEARCHER, THE COMMUNITY, AND THE KNOWLEDGE ITSELF. THIS PERSPECTIVE CONTRASTS SHARPLY WITH WESTERN RESEARCH PARADIGMS THAT OFTEN PRIORITIZE OBJECTIVITY AND DETACHMENT.

WILSON'S APPROACH DRAWS ON HIS OWN INDIGENOUS HERITAGE AND PHILOSOPHICAL UNDERSTANDINGS, EMPHASIZING THAT CONDUCTING RESEARCH IS A FORM OF ENGAGING IN A RELATIONSHIP WITH THE WORLD AND ITS INHABITANTS. BY FRAMING RESEARCH AS CEREMONY, HE UNDERSCORES THE ETHICAL DIMENSIONS AND THE NECESSITY OF HONORING INDIGENOUS PROTOCOLS THROUGHOUT THE RESEARCH JOURNEY.

PHILOSOPHICAL FOUNDATIONS

THE PHILOSOPHICAL UNDERPINNINGS OF RESEARCH IS CEREMONY ARE GROUNDED IN INDIGENOUS EPISTEMOLOGIES THAT VIEW KNOWLEDGE AS RELATIONAL AND INTERCONNECTED. WILSON ASSERTS THAT KNOWLEDGE IS NOT AN ISOLATED COMMODITY BUT SOMETHING THAT EMERGES FROM RELATIONSHIPS AMONG PEOPLE, LAND, ANCESTORS, AND SPIRIT. RESEARCH, THEREFORE, BECOMES A PROCESS OF NURTURING AND MAINTAINING THESE RELATIONSHIPS, WHICH REQUIRES HUMILITY, RESPECT, AND A COMMITMENT TO THE WELL-BEING OF ALL INVOLVED.

DISTINCTION FROM WESTERN RESEARCH PARADIGMS

UNLIKE WESTERN RESEARCH METHODOLOGIES THAT EMPHASIZE DETACHMENT AND OBJECTIVITY, WILSON'S MODEL DEMANDS ENGAGEMENT AND ACCOUNTABILITY. THE RESEARCHER IS SEEN AS A PARTICIPANT WITHIN THE RESEARCH CONTEXT RATHER THAN

AN EXTERNAL OBSERVER. THIS SHIFT CALLS FOR A REEVALUATION OF STANDARD RESEARCH ETHICS TO INCLUDE INDIGENOUS PROTOCOLS, CEREMONIES, AND RELATIONAL COMMITMENTS.

CORE PRINCIPLES OF RESEARCH IS CEREMONY

ETHICS AS CEREMONY
