COLONIAL FOUNDATIONS AND EARLY SETTLEMENT

THE AMERICAN REVOLUTION AND NATION BUILDING

DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE AND WAR

IN 1776, THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE FORMALLY ASSERTED THE COLONIES' INTENT TO FORM A SOVEREIGN NATION. THE REVOLUTIONARY WAR FOLLOWED, INVOLVING SIGNIFICANT MILITARY ENGAGEMENTS AND ALLIANCES, NOTABLY WITH FRANCE. THE WAR CULMINATED IN BRITISH DEFEAT AND RECOGNITION OF AMERICAN INDEPENDENCE.

FORMATION OF GOVERNMENT AND CONSTITUTION

SLAVERY AND SECTIONAL TENSIONS

THE CIVIL WAR AND RECONSTRUCTION
