THE ORIGINS OF THE COLD WAR

THESE EFFORTS AIMED TO COUNTER PERCEIVED SUBVERSION AND MAINTAIN IDEOLOGICAL PURITY DURING THE COLD WAR.

SOVIET PROPAGANDA AND CONTROL
