INTERPERSONAL RELATIONSHIPS STUDY ATTRACTION, LOVE, AGGRESSION, AND ALTRUISM. THESE ELEMENTS HELP EXPLAIN HOW SOCIAL BONDS FORM AND INFLUENCE HUMAN INTERACTION.
