- **STUTTERING SEVERITY INSTRUMENT (SSI):** EVALUATES FLUENCY AND STUTTERING SEVERITY.
- **VOICE HANDICAP INDEX (VHI):** ASSESSES VOICE DISORDERS THROUGH SELF-REPORT.
