HISTORICAL AND CULTURAL CONTEXT OF TALES FROM THE SOUTH PACIFIC

THE SOUTH PACIFIC REGION IS HOME TO A VAST ARRAY OF ISLANDS, EACH WITH ITS OWN DISTINCT CULTURE AND HISTORY. INFLUENCE OF COLONIALISM AND EXPLORATION

IMPACT OF WORLD WAR II ON SOUTH PACIFIC STORIES

WORLD WAR II SIGNIFICANTLY INFLUENCED TALES FROM THE SOUTH PACIFIC, AS THE REGION BECAME A STRATEGIC BATTLEGROUND. THE WAR INTRODUCED NEW NARRATIVES CENTERED ON MILITARY EXPERIENCES, CROSS-CULTURAL INTERACTIONS, AND THE SOCIAL CHANGES THAT FOLLOWED.
