THE TEXAS COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE (CDL) PROGRAM IS DESIGNED TO ENSURE THAT COMMERCIAL DRIVERS MEET SPECIFIC KNOWLEDGE AND SKILL REQUIREMENTS BEFORE OPERATING LARGE OR SPECIALIZED VEHICLES. THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY (DPS) ADMINISTERS THE CDL EXAMS, WHICH CONSIST OF WRITTEN KNOWLEDGE TESTS AND A SKILLS TEST. APPLICANTS MUST FIRST PASS THE WRITTEN EXAMS COVERING GENERAL KNOWLEDGE AND ANY ENDORSEMENTS THEY REQUIRE. AFTER PASSING THE WRITTEN PORTION, THE SKILLS TEST EVALUATES DRIVING PROFICIENCY, INCLUDING PRE-TRIP INSPECTIONS, BASIC VEHICLE CONTROL, AND ON-ROAD DRIVING.

TYPES OF TEXAS CDL LICENSES

- **CLASS B:** PERMITS DRIVING SINGLE VEHICLES WITH A GROSS VEHICLE WEIGHT RATING (GVWR) OF 26,001 POUNDS OR MORE, OR TOWING A VEHICLE NOT HEAVIER THAN 10,000 POUNDS.
- **CLASS C:** REQUIRED FOR VEHICLES DESIGNED TO TRANSPORT 16 OR MORE PASSENGERS INCLUDING THE DRIVER, OR HAZARDOUS MATERIALS REQUIRING PLACARDING.

THE TYPE OF LICENSE DETERMINES WHICH WRITTEN TESTS ARE NECESSARY AND WHICH ENDORSEMENTS MAY BE ADDED.

TYPES OF TEXAS CDL QUESTIONS

THE TEXAS CDL WRITTEN EXAMS FEATURE A VARIETY OF QUESTION FORMATS DESIGNED TO ASSESS APPLICANTS' KNOWLEDGE OF COMMERCIAL DRIVING LAWS, SAFETY PRACTICES, AND VEHICLE OPERATION. ANSWER: THE MAXIMUM BAC FOR A COMMERCIAL DRIVER IS 0.04%. ANY LEVEL ABOVE THIS IS A VIOLATION AND CAN RESULT IN SEVERE PENALTIES, INCLUDING SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION OF THE CDL.
