THE NEOLITHIC REVOLUTION

ANCIENT CIVILIZATIONS AND THE BIRTH OF CITIES

ANCIENT EGYPT AND THE NILE CIVILIZATION

EGYPTIAN CIVILIZATION FLOURISHED ALONG THE NILE RIVER, BENEFITING FROM PREDICTABLE FLOODING THAT ENRICHED THE SOIL. THE EGYPTIANS BUILT PYRAMIDS, DEVELOPED HIEROGLYPHIC WRITING, AND ESTABLISHED A CENTRALIZED STATE UNDER PHARAOHS.
