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HISTORICAL CONTEXT OF "THE RAVEN"

UNDERSTANDING THE HISTORICAL BACKDROP OF "THE RAVEN" IS ESSENTIAL TO FULLY GRASP THE POEM'S DEPTH. THEMATIC EXPLORATION

PERSONIFICATION

THE RAVEN IS PERSONIFIED AS A SENTIENT BEING CAPABLE OF SPEECH AND DELIBERATE ACTION, WHICH DEEPENS THE SUPERNATURAL DIMENSION OF THE POEM AND THE NARRATOR’S PSYCHOLOGICAL CONFLICT.
