2. **RULE:** NEGLIGENCE REQUIRES DUTY, BREACH, CAUSATION, AND DAMAGES. DUTY EXISTS AS DRIVERS OWE A DUTY TO PEDESTRIANS TO OBEY TRAFFIC LAWS. BREACH OCCURS IF THE DRIVER RUNS A RED LIGHT.
3. **APPLICATION:** THE DRIVER BREACHED THE DUTY BY RUNNING THE RED LIGHT. THIS BREACH CAUSED THE PEDESTRIAN'S INJURY. THE PEDESTRIAN'S PARTIAL FAULT MAY REDUCE RECOVERY UNDER COMPARATIVE NEGLIGENCE RULES.
4. **CONCLUSION:** THE DRIVER IS LIABLE FOR NEGLIGENCE, ALTHOUGH DAMAGES MAY BE REDUCED BASED ON THE PEDESTRIAN'S CONTRIBUTORY FAULT.

SAMPLE QUESTION 2: INTENTIONAL TORT – BATTERY

2. **RULE:** BATTERY IS THE INTENTIONAL HARMFUL OR OFFENSIVE CONTACT WITH ANOTHER PERSON WITHOUT CONSENT. SELF-DEFENSE IS A VALID DEFENSE IF THE FORCE USED WAS REASONABLE.
3. **APPLICATION:** THE DEFENDANT INTENTIONALLY STRUCK THE PLAINTIFF, SATISFYING THE ELEMENTS OF BATTERY. HOWEVER, IF THE DEFENDANT REASONABLY BELIEVED FORCE WAS NECESSARY FOR PROTECTION, SELF-DEFENSE MAY APPLY.
4. **CONCLUSION:** LIABILITY DEPENDS ON THE REASONABLENESS OF THE SELF-DEFENSE CLAIM; IF JUSTIFIED, THE DEFENDANT IS NOT LIABLE FOR BATTERY.

CAUSATION INVOLVES BOTH ACTUAL CAUSE (CAUSE-IN-FACT) AND PROXIMATE CAUSE (LEGAL CAUSE). THE PLAINTIFF MUST PROVE THAT THE DEFENDANT'S CONDUCT WAS THE CAUSE OF THE HARM. DAMAGES REFER TO THE ACTUAL LOSSES SUFFERED, WHICH CAN BE ECONOMIC OR NON-ECONOMIC. PROPER ASSESSMENT OF CAUSATION AND DAMAGES IS ESSENTIAL IN ANSWERING TORTS EXAM QUESTIONS ACCURATELY.

DEFENSES TO TORTS
