ANSWERING THESE QUESTIONS GROUNDS THE ACTOR IN THE CHARACTER'S REALITY AND INFORMS CHOICES THROUGHOUT THE PERFORMANCE.

IMPROVISATION AND SENSE MEMORY

IMPROVISATION EXERCISES ENCOURAGE SPONTANEITY AND RESPONSIVENESS, WHILE SENSE MEMORY HELPS ACTORS RECALL PHYSICAL SENSATIONS AND EMOTIONS TO ENRICH THEIR PORTRAYAL. BOTH TECHNIQUES PROMOTE A VIBRANT AND DYNAMIC STAGE PRESENCE.

PHILOSOPHICAL FOUNDATIONS OF HAGEN'S APPROACH
