BEHAVIORAL ENGAGEMENT

COMPLEX CONCEPTS AND SOLVING PROBLEMS. THIS TYPE OF ENGAGEMENT ENCOURAGES DEEP LEARNING AND CRITICAL THINKING RATHER THAN SURFACE-LEVEL MEMORIZATION. STRATEGIES FOR COGNITIVE ENGAGEMENT CHALLENGE STUDENTS TO ANALYZE, EVALUATE, AND SYNTHESIZE INFORMATION CREATIVELY.

BEHAVIORAL ENGAGEMENT TECHNIQUES
