- **HORSE:** MIMICS HOLDING REINS OR TAPS THE SIDE OF THE HEAD TO REPRESENT EARS.
- **ELEPHANT:** EXTENDING THE ARM FORWARD WITH A CURVED HAND SIMULATING A TRUNK.
- **RABBIT:** TWO FINGERS HOPPING UP IN FRONT OF THE HEAD RESEMBLING EARS.

Non-Manual Signals in Animal Signs

NON-MANUAL SIGNALS SUCH AS FACIAL EXPRESSIONS AND BODY MOVEMENTS ENHANCE THE MEANING OF ANIMAL SIGNS.
