BLOOD AT THE ROOT IS A PHRASE THAT CARRIES SIGNIFICANT HISTORICAL, CULTURAL, AND LITERARY WEIGHT. THE LYRICS, "BLOOD ON THE LEAVES AND BLOOD AT THE ROOT," EMPHASIZE THE PERVASIVE NATURE OF RACIAL VIOLENCE, SUGGESTING IT IS NOT AN ISOLATED INCIDENT BUT INTEGRAL TO THE SOCIETAL STRUCTURE. THIS ARTISTIC USE HAS HELPED EMBED THE PHRASE IN CULTURAL MEMORY AS A SYMBOL OF RACIAL INJUSTICE.

METAPHORICAL INTERPRETATIONS
