SLAVERY AS A CENTRAL CAUSE

SLAVERY WAS THE MOST SIGNIFICANT AND CONTENTIOUS CAUSE OF THE CIVIL WAR. THE INSTITUTION OF SLAVERY DEEPLY DIVIDED THE NATION, CREATING MORAL, ECONOMIC, AND POLITICAL CONFLICTS THAT BECAME INCREASINGLY IRRECONCILABLE. SOUTHERN STATES DEPENDED HEAVILY ON SLAVE LABOR FOR THEIR AGRICULTURAL ECONOMY, PARTICULARLY IN COTTON PRODUCTION, WHILE NORTHERN STATES MOVED TOWARD INDUSTRIALIZATION AND WERE LARGELY OPPOSED TO SLAVERY'S EXPANSION.

THE MORAL DEBATE OVER SLAVERY

THE ABOLITIONIST MOVEMENT IN THE NORTH INTENSIFIED THE MORAL OPPOSITION TO SLAVERY. MANY NORTHERNERS VIEWED SLAVERY AS AN INHUMANE AND UNJUST PRACTICE THAT SHOULD BE ABOLISHED NATIONWIDE. THIS GROWING MORAL IMPERATIVE CREATED FRICTION WITH SOUTHERN STATES, WHERE SLAVERY WAS DEFENDED AS A NECESSARY AND JUSTIFIED INSTITUTION.

EXPANSION OF SLAVERY INTO NEW TERRITORIES

CONTROVERSY AROSE OVER WHETHER NEW TERRITORIES AND STATES ADMITTED TO THE UNION WOULD PERMIT SLAVERY. THE MISSOURI COMPROMISE AND LATER THE KANSAS-NEBRASKA ACT ATTEMPTED TO ADDRESS THIS ISSUE BUT ULTIMATELY HEIGHTENED TENSIONS, AS BOTH SIDES FEARED LOSING POLITICAL POWER DEPENDING ON THE STATUS OF SLAVERY IN THE TERRITORIES.

STATES' RIGHTS AND SOVEREIGNTY

CONFLICTS OVER STATES' RIGHTS AND THE EXTENT OF FEDERAL AUTHORITY WERE CENTRAL TO THE CAUSES OF THE CIVIL WAR. SOUTHERN STATES ASSERTED THAT THEY HAD THE RIGHT TO GOVERN THEMSELVES AND MAKE THEIR OWN DECISIONS ABOUT ISSUES LIKE SLAVERY WITHOUT INTERFERENCE FROM THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.

THE DOCTRINE OF NULLIFICATION

THE NULLIFICATION CRISIS OF THE 1830S, WHEN SOUTH CAROLINA ATTEMPTED TO NULLIFY FEDERAL TARIFFS, EXEMPLIFIED THE GROWING BELIEF IN STATES' RIGHTS. THIS DOCTRINE HELD THAT STATES COULD INVALIDATE FEDERAL LAWS THEY DEEMED UNCONSTITUTIONAL, A STANCE THAT CHALLENGED THE AUTHORITY OF THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT.

SECESSION AND THE QUESTION OF UNION

THE CONCEPT OF SECESSION—STATES LEAVING THE UNION—BECAME A CRITICAL ISSUE AS SOUTHERN STATES FELT THEIR RIGHTS WERE UNDER THREAT. THE ELECTION OF ABRAHAM LINCOLN IN 1860, VIEWED BY MANY SOUTHERNERS AS HOSTILE TO THEIR INTERESTS, PROMPTED THE FIRST WAVE OF SECESSION DECLARATIONS, LEADING DIRECTLY TO THE OUTBREAK OF WAR.

ECONOMIC DIFFERENCES BETWEEN NORTH AND SOUTH

ECONOMIC DISPARITIES BETWEEN THE INDUSTRIAL NORTH AND THE AGRARIAN SOUTH PLAYED A CRUCIAL ROLE IN CAUSING THE CIVIL WAR. THESE DIFFERENCES CONTRIBUTED TO CONFLICTING INTERESTS REGARDING TARIFFS, INFRASTRUCTURE DEVELOPMENT, AND LABOR SYSTEMS.

INDUSTRIALIZATION VS. AGRICULTURE

THE NORTH DEVELOPED A DIVERSE ECONOMY BASED ON MANUFACTURING, COMMERCE, AND FINANCE, WHILE THE SOUTH REMAINED LARGELY DEPENDENT ON AGRICULTURE, PARTICULARLY COTTON FARMING UTILIZING SLAVE LABOR. THIS DIVERGENCE SHAPED DIFFERING ECONOMIC PRIORITIES AND POLITICAL AGENDAS.

TARIFFS AND TRADE DISPUTES

TARIFFS ON IMPORTED GOODS WERE FAVORED BY NORTHERN INDUSTRIES TO PROTECT THEM FROM FOREIGN COMPETITION BUT WERE OPPOSED BY THE SOUTH, WHICH RELIED ON IMPORTING GOODS AND EXPORTING COTTON. THESE ECONOMIC DISAGREEMENTS ADDED TO SECTIONAL TENSIONS AND POLITICAL STRIFE.

POLITICAL CONFLICTS AND COMPROMISES

POLITICAL STRUGGLES OVER REPRESENTATION, THE BALANCE OF POWER, AND LEGISLATION CONCERNING SLAVERY INTENSIFIED THE DIVIDE BETWEEN NORTH AND SOUTH. SEVERAL COMPROMISES ATTEMPTED TO MAINTAIN PEACE BUT ULTIMATELY FAILED TO RESOLVE UNDERLYING ISSUES.

THE MISSOURI COMPROMISE

PASSED IN 1820, THE MISSOURI COMPROMISE ADMITTED MISSOURI AS A SLAVE STATE AND MAINE AS A FREE STATE, MAINTAINING THE BALANCE IN THE SENATE. IT ALSO ESTABLISHED A GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARY FOR SLAVERY'S EXPANSION, BUT THIS SOLUTION WAS TEMPORARY AND DIVISIVE.

THE COMPROMISE OF 1850

THIS PACKAGE OF LAWS AIMED TO DEFUSE SECTIONAL TENSIONS BY ADMITTING CALIFORNIA AS A FREE STATE AND ENACTING A STRICTER FUGITIVE SLAVE LAW. HOWEVER, IT SATISFIED NEITHER SIDE FULLY AND CONTRIBUTED TO GROWING HOSTILITY.

THE KANSAS-NEBRASKA ACT

ENACTED IN 1854, THIS LAW ALLOWED SETTLERS IN KANSAS AND NEBRASKA TO DECIDE THE ISSUE OF SLAVERY BY POPULAR SOVEREIGNTY. THE RESULT WAS VIOLENT CONFLICT KNOWN AS "BLEEDING KANSAS," WHICH FORESHADOWED THE LARGER WAR TO COME.

SOCIAL AND CULTURAL DIVIDES

BEYOND ECONOMICS AND POLITICS, SOCIAL AND CULTURAL DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE NORTH AND SOUTH FUELED MISTRUST AND MISUNDERSTANDING. THESE CULTURAL DIVISIONS REINFORCED REGIONAL IDENTITIES AND HARDENED ATTITUDES TOWARD COMPROMISE.

SECTIONALISM AND REGIONAL IDENTITY

PEOPLE IN THE NORTH AND SOUTH INCREASINGLY IDENTIFIED WITH THEIR OWN REGION'S CULTURE AND INTERESTS. THIS SECTIONALISM LED TO STEREOTYPES AND HOSTILITY, REDUCING THE WILLINGNESS TO FIND COMMON GROUND.

ROLE OF RELIGION AND EDUCATION

RELIGIOUS BELIEFS AND EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS OFTEN REFLECTED AND REINFORCED REGIONAL ATTITUDES, WITH NORTHERN CHURCHES TENDING TO OPPOSE SLAVERY AND SOUTHERN CHURCHES DEFENDING IT. THESE DIVISIONS PERMEATED MANY AREAS OF SOCIAL LIFE, INTENSIFYING CONFLICT.

KEY EVENTS LEADING TO WAR

CERTAIN PIVOTAL EVENTS DIRECTLY PRECIPITATED THE OUTBREAK OF THE CIVIL WAR BY ESCALATING TENSIONS AND POLARIZING PUBLIC OPINION.

JOHN BROWN'S RAID ON HARPERS FERRY

IN 1859, ABOLITIONIST JOHN BROWN ATTEMPTED TO INITIATE A SLAVE UPRISING BY SEIZING THE FEDERAL ARSENAL AT HARPERS FERRY. THOUGH UNSUCCESSFUL, THE RAID ALARMED SOUTHERNERS AND INCREASED FEARS OF NORTHERN AGGRESSION.

THE ELECTION OF 1860

ABRAHAM LINCOLN'S ELECTION AS PRESIDENT WITHOUT ANY SOUTHERN ELECTORAL VOTES CONVINCED MANY SOUTHERN STATES THAT THEIR INFLUENCE IN THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT WAS ENDING. THIS EVENT TRIGGERED THE SECESSION OF MULTIPLE STATES AND THE FORMATION OF THE CONFEDERACY.

ATTACK ON FORT SUMTER

THE CONFEDERATE ATTACK ON FORT SUMTER IN APRIL 1861 MARKED THE OFFICIAL START OF THE CIVIL WAR. THIS VIOLENT CONFRONTATION WAS THE CULMINATION OF YEARS OF UNRESOLVED DISPUTES OVER THE CAUSES DISCUSSED ABOVE.
